

PERTH - BREMER BAY by ROAD

- (1) Make your way from Perth to Armadale. Take Albany Highway. Continue on through Williams.
- (2) 20 kilometers past Williams you will come across a turnoff to the left to Piesseville. Take it.
- (3) After about 37 kilometers you will reach a T-junction. Turn right.
After another 5 kilometers you will reach another T-junction with a service station on your left. Make a left hand turn into Wagin townsite. Proceed down the main street. At the end of town, just before the railway line, there is a turn to the right to Katanning. Take it.
- (4) Continue on, you will pass through Woodanilling, Katanning and then Broomehill.
- (5) 5 kilometers past Broomehill you will come across a turnoff to Gnowangerup on your left (it will take you over a railway line).
Pass through Gnowangerup (the road veers to the left at the top of the main street. Follow it.
- (6) 29 kilometers past Gnowangerup you will come to a T-Junction. Turn right towards Borden. The township of Borden is to your right about 6 kilometers down the road. Continue on the main road (do not turn into the township). 7 kilometers past Borden you will come across the Bremer Bay turnoff to your left. Take it.
- (7) Follow the road for another 56 kilometers until you reach another T-Junction (Boxwood Hill). Do a right-left dogleg into the Bremer Bay road. Follow the road – 60 kilometers and you are there.

COMING FROM AN EASTERLY DIRECTION

Proceed along the South West Highway in a westerly direction, continue past Jerramungup until you reach the Gardiner-South Road turnoff on your left. Take it. This will bring you out onto the Bremer Road. Turn left. Bremer Bay is approx. 40 kilometers down the road.
